Thank you for enquiring about Serare School.

Serare School is runs the Kenyan Govt. curriculum.

- Students are engaged in co-curricular activities like Art, Music, French, Excursions, Swimming and other sports disciplines. ICT is integrated in all subjects taught.
- Some course books are given to pupils. A book levy is charged to cater for this.
- The Refundable Deposit is only refunded at the end of Class 8 or at PU. It can also be refunded if the child transfers before this time and give 3 months' notice.
- External exam e.g. KCPE, Music ABRSM, French Delf Diploma will attract a fee and will be advised.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. All invoiced fees should be paid in **full** by the 2nd week of a new school term.
2. If you would like to *change any request*, please do so by the 2nd week of the new school term. Any later than this the initial invoice will need to be paid in full.
3. A term's notice is required if you wish to withdraw your child from Serare School.
4. School fees is revised at the beginning of each academic year, and may increase at reasonable levels in line with normal price inflation in Kenya.

PAYMENT METHODS:

Payment of school fees can be made at the bank¹ through a cash deposit or banker's cheque, bank transfer², MPESA. Payments are made termly, and must be made on time.
